JerseyCat: Do-Your-Own Interlibrary Loans

If we don't have what you're looking for, check JerseyCat, an interlibrary loan system of over 250 NJ libraries. Please check our catalog first. We cannot interlibrary loan an item we already own, please place a request for the item our catalog.

You can do your own interlibrary loan requests, check on their progress, and when ready for pick up, we'll call you!

Please, limit ILL requests to no more than 5 per day.

1. Go to our webpage www.mtlaurel.lib.nj.us and click on the Services tab across the top.
2. On the services page, click on interlibrary loan and requests.
3. Click the large interlibrary loan button.
4. Click begin.
5. Enter a title, author, subject or keywords in the search box.
6. Click Search
JerseyCat searches 200+ libraries in the NJ State Union catalog
7. At the List of Results, double click on the title you want
8. Click on the Request This Item on the left.
9. On the ILL Request Form, fill in these fields

Patron Name: Your LAST NAME, First name

Create a Password: Choose (*and remember*) a password to check your do-it-yourself ILL requests

Library Card Number: Your Mount Laurel Library number

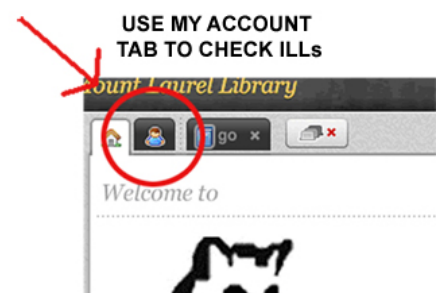
Phone/Fax/Email: Your area code + phone number

10. Click Submit button
11. The Library will contact you when your items arrive for pick-up. They will be on the self-pickup holds shelf.

HOW TO CHECK YOUR REQUESTS



1. Once in the ILL system, click on the MY ACCOUNT tab.
2. Enter your name and password exactly as on the request.
3. Only self-submitted ILLs will appear—those done by library staff won't show.
