Ten-year-old Auggie Pullman, who was born with extreme facial abnormalities and was not expected to survive, goes from being home-schooled to entering fifth grade at a private middle school in Manhattan, which entails enduring the taunting and fear of his classmates as he struggles to be seen as just another student. The Mother-Daughter Book Club by Heather Vogel Frederick. When the mothers of four sixth-grade girls with very different personalities pressure them into forming a book club, they find they have much more in common than they could have imagined. Call No. Juv Paperbacks FREDE
