Kindle Updated for the NEW Overdrive Interface

Borrow Kindle books from Mount Laurel Library's website and, with a click of a button, have them delivered to your Kindle device or free reading app.

Instructions:

- Go to www.mtlaurel.lib.nj.us 1.
- 2. Click on eBooks (under the Downloads tab).
- 3. Click on Ebooks from Overdrive.
- Click on Account (upper right). 4.
- 5. Choose Mount Laurel Library from the drop-down list.
- Type in your library card number without spaces. 6.
- 7. Click Sign in.
- Click on Advanced Search (upper right hand side). 8.
- 9. Select Kindle Book from the Formats field.
- 10. Include other search terms (author, title, subject, etc), if you wish.
- 11. Choose "Show only titles with copies available," if you wish.
- 12. Click Search.
- 13. Narrow your search using options on the left or click on a book cover.
- 14. Click on Borrow.
- 15. Click on Download (next to the book cover), choose Kindle Book.
- Click Confirm & Download. (This will take you to the Amazon.com page.) 16.
- 17. Click Get Library Book.
- Sign into Amazon.com with your Amazon.com account information. 18.
- 19. Choose where you want the eBook to be delivered. Click Continue.
- 20. The eBook will appear on your device as soon as it connects to Wi-Fi.

Note: Public library books require an active Wi-Fi connection for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. Library books will not be delivered via your Kindle's 3G connection. If trying to send to a Kindle device and you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, you may instead choose to load your library book via USB.

Downloading via USB - (required for Penguin publisher titles) follow steps 1-18, then...

- 19. Connect your computer to your Kindle with your USB.
- 20. Click Download Now
- 21. Click on Save
- 22. Choose Kindle from My Computer locations.
- 23. Choose documents file
- Click Save. 24.
- 25. The eBook should appear on your Kindle. Enjoy!
