

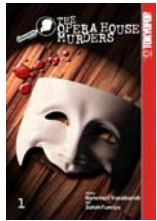

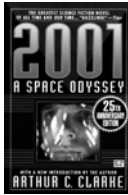

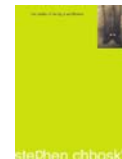
Lord of the Rings by J.R.R. Tolkien- David
