Members in attendance: 10.

Meeting led by Sam.

1. Review of minutes from previous meeting. Sam talked enthusiastically about Rock Band.
2. New Program update. We will be booking Stage Struck (drawing, etc) programs for next year. We will continue teen crafts as long as the interest continues. Suggested crafts include cooking and tie dye.
